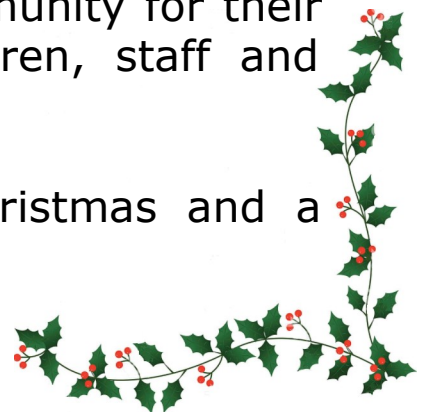

Update on Scarlet Fever & Invasive Group A Strep

We recently sent home information from the UKHSA regarding the media reports about cases of scarlet fever and invasive Group A strep in children.

Scarlet fever is usually a mild illness but it is highly infectious. Look out for symptoms in your child, which include a sore throat, headache and fever, along with a fine, pinkish or red body rash with a sandpapery feel. On darker skin the rash can be more difficult to detect visually but will have a sandpapery feel.

Where to get help and information

Contact NHS 111 or your GP if you suspect your child has scarlet fever because early treatment with antibiotics is important to reduce the risk of complications such as pneumonia or a bloodstream infection.

If your child has scarlet fever, keep them at home until at least 24 hours after the start of antibiotic treatment to avoid spreading the infection to others.
